- Jefferson County is home to the Rocky Mountain
 Metropolitan Airport (RMMA), the 4th busiest airport in
 Colorado with over 190,000 operations annually. In 2020,
 RMMA had an estimated \$731 million economic impact
 for the region.
- RMMA has over 170 acres reserved for future aeronautical use, which sits adjacent to the Verve Innovation Park, a 630-acre mixed-use development opportunity.
- RMMA recently welcomed new commercial service operations to Burbank, Dallas, Las Vegas, and Phoenix.
- Jefferson County has a business-friendly environment.
 To support the business community, the county recently eliminated its portion of the business personal property tax, becoming the first county in Colorado to completely eliminate this tax.
- Jeffco EDC recently established a foreign trade zone (FTZ No. 298) for Jefferson County, which will reduce taxes and tariffs for businesses and improve global competitiveness.
